

Where in the World is Matt, today?



The anchor was 11,745 feet above sea level at Jungfrau's Sphinx Observatory, located in the Swiss Alps.


The mountains are home to snowy peaks and lush valleys. Towns accessible only by cable car dot the landscape.


You can get there by taking a train, like Matt did. It's the highest railway station in Europe.


Thankfully, this morning was beautiful: 23 degrees Fahrenheit with a sun so intense that Matt didn't need a coat.




Jungfrau Observatory is most famous for being the breathtaking setting for the 1969 James Bond film, "On Her Majesty's Secret Service."
